The Department of Family Services has completed the investigation regarding alleged violation(s) of the Wyoming Child Care Rules received on 11/19/2019, and investigated by Kristi Bennick

A statement of childcare allegation, CPL-44695, was provided on 11/26/2019.

The finding is listed below for each individual alleged violation of the Wyoming Child Care Licensing Rules:

1. Finding: Non-Compliant

Regulation:

Chapter 4. General Requirements

Section 3. Provider, Director, and Staff Requirement

(a) Before the provider, director, their staff, household member, substitute or volunteer assume responsibility for the direct care of children, work in the facility or move into the Family Child Care Home or Family Child Care Center, the following shall be on file:

(iii) A child abuse/neglect Central Registry check which does not reveal any disqualifying information.

Explanation of Findings: A finding of non-compliance is based on observation by licensing on 11/19/19 at 1:40pm. Licensor reviewed records and there was not out of state central registry results on file from Montana for Jenna Leader. Jenna was at the facility at time of the visit and was being used in ratios. Jenna stated she had not filled out paperwork for the state of Montana.

Action Required: At the time of visit on 11/19/19 at 1:40pm visit, Jenna Leader left the facility. Kayla Williams filled out a variance request for Jenna's out of state central registry. Please submit corrective action plan discussing how you will maintain compliance in only used qualified staff at the facility.

Administrative hearing procedures are included in the Wyoming Department of Family Services Contested Case Hearing Rules, Chapter 2, Substitute Care and Child Care Licensing and based on the above statute. If you need a copy of the Rules, or assistance in requesting an Administrative hearing, you may contact the Department of Family Services Field Office in the county where you live.
